We are pleased to announce that SerenaGroup has partnered with Mendota Health to provide advanced wound care to homebound patients. Until recently, this group of patients did not have access to advanced wound care technology. Collaboration with Mendota allows us to care for patients in all service venues. Mobile wound care is complementary to our outpatient wound care program. Patients requiring excisional debridement, hyperbaric oxygen and vascular intervention, for example, will be referred to the wound care centers. We anticipate improved care for patients who cannot travel to the outpatient center and increased volume in the wound care centers as we reach a much larger population of patients suffering from chronic wounds.

Who is Mendota Health?

Mendota Health gives wound care patients the care they need through our mobile outpatient wound care clinic. The team is made up of nurse practitioners who go to the patient's home bringing with them everything necessary to provide complete and total wound care.

We believe partnering with Mendota Health will allow our physician community to extend the safest and best possible care to patients. Mendota Health is a collaborative practice that works with wound clinics and health systems across the United States to ensure any patient who needs expert advanced wound care can receive it. They focus on reducing readmission rates, help patients successfully transition home, and increase clinical efficiency by taking on patients who are non-compliant, no shows, and take a lot of provider time in clinic.

Determining the Competence of Your Employees

What is the most important aspect of our Director positions in our Advanced Wound Care Centers?

Strategic decision making, marketing of services, making an impact, and a list of other equally important things?

All of these are very important for success; However, the largest responsibility our directors have are "determining the competence of the clinical team." Unfortunately, competence is often overlooked and only gets its rightful amount of time when the triennial survey occurs for the Joint Commission or the DNV. And that is typically when directors discover items are missing from an employee file.

So how do we prevent this from occurring? By reviewing what SerenaGroup's expectations are for the Director and employees, regardless of whether they are employed by the company or the hospital.

At the time of hiring, there are tools that directors are expected to follow to ensure a complete onboarding is completed for each staff member. As an example, regardless of position, the following must occur, prior to the start date: verification of the license, verification of certifications and a background check. All are required by the federal and state governments.

The SerenaGroup Directors should anticipate the employee's first day and be prepared by having the orientation checklist prepared and all associated documentation available to the new hire. SerenaGroup has put together a standardize orientation for all positions; RN, LPN/LVN, MA, HBO Tech, Front Desk, Director, etc.

SerenaGroup standardized this process to ensure that from the first day of hire all employees get adequate training with an standardized process no matter what center they join. This is the "Roadmap for Success in the SerenaGroup Advanced Wound Care Center" by outlining the minimum elements to be employed in our centers.

No matter why type of contact that is in place with SerenaGroup for management of the center,
SerenaGroup ensures all elements of competence for all employees are met, assessed on an initial and ongoing basis, and sustained.


