- Encourage new patients to bring a support person.



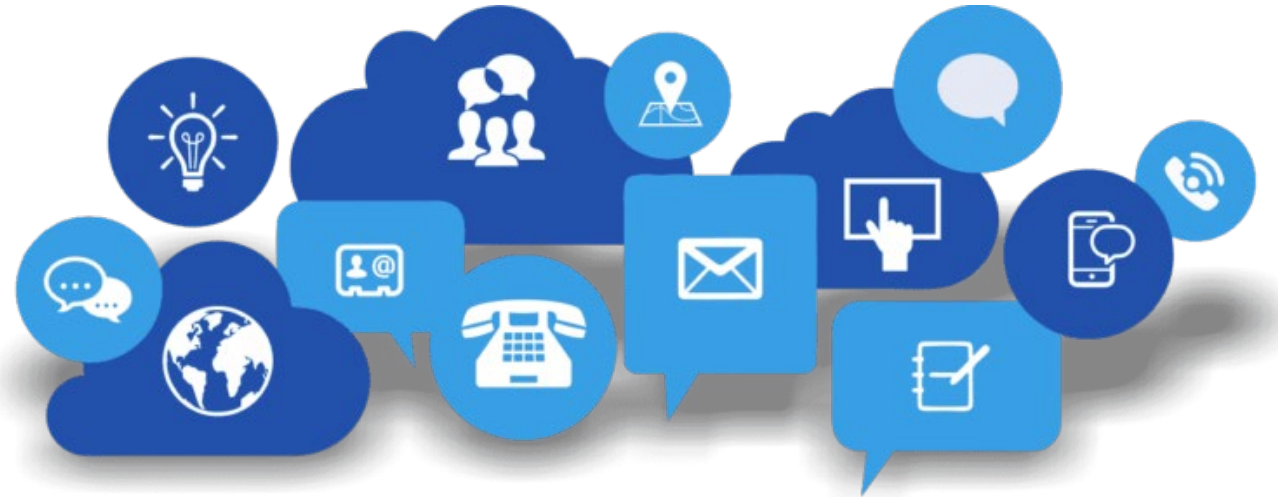
